ORDER OF THE IMMIGRATION JUDGE

On 09/21/2022, a review of the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) credible fear determination was held in this matter. This Court did did not take testimony regarding the Applicant's background and the Applicant's fear of returning to their country of origin or last habitual residence.

After *de novo* consideration, the Court determines that the Applicant has has not demonstrated a significant possibility that the Applicant could establish eligibility for asylum under section 208 of the Act, withholding of removal under section 241(b)(3) of the Act, or protection under the Convention Against Torture. *See* INA §§ 208, 241(b)(3); 8 C.F.R. §§ 1003.42(d), 1208.18.

ORDER: It is hereby ordered:

- The DHS credible fear determination is **AFFIRMED** and the case is returned to DHS for removal of the Applicant. *See* 8 C.F.R. §§ 1003.42(f), 1208.30(g)(2)(iv)(A).
- The removal order is **VACATED** and the case is returned to DHS for further proceedings. *See* 8 C.F.R. §§ 1003.42(f), 1208.30(g)(2)(iv)(B).

This is a final order. There is no appeal available. The Applicant may, however, request that DHS reconsider a negative credible fear determination with which the Immigration Judge has concurred, if certain conditions are met.
